GRAMMAR . Can and can't for ability

To talk about ability, use can or can't and the base form of a verb.







Josie can't cook.

Questions
Can you play the guitar?
Can he speak English?

Short answers
Yes, I can. / No, I can't.
Yes, he can. / No, he can't.

Use can or can't with well to indicate degree of ability.

She can play the guitar, but she can't play well.

can't = can not = cannot

Could you ..?

Form: Could you + base form of verb?

Examples:

Could you carry my bags? Could you give me some advice? Could you carry these boxes?

We can add "possibly" to be even more polite. We put "possibly" in between "Could you" and the verb.

Example:

Could you possibly hold my drink?
