PRESENT PROGRESSIVE

Meaning	Form	Use
The present progressive is a verb tense which is used to show that an ongoing action is happening now, either at the moment of speech or now in a larger sense.	+ am/is/are + verbing + comp. -Statement: You are watching TV. -Question: Are you watching TV? -Negative: You are not watching TV.	Use 1: Use the present progressive to express the idea that something is happening now, at this very moment. It can also be used to show that something is not happening now. EXAMPLES: 1. You are learning English now. 2. You are not swimming now. 3. Are you sleeping? 4. I am sitting. 5. I am not standing. 6. Is he sitting or standing? 7. They are reading their books. 8. They are not watching television.
